### **YOUTH SWIM LESSONS**

The Youth Swim Lesson Program is designed to develop each participant's potential by incorporating a developmental approach that is based on current research in child development, the art of teaching, motor learning, and motor development. Through qualified instruction, children can begin to swim for the first time, improve swim skills, learn water safety techniques and enjoy personal growth.

### **LEVELS & EVALUATIONS**

Swim evaluations are required for all participants. Evaluations are conducted every week from for those who have not participated in previous YMCA swim lessons. If children have completed a level at another YMCA, please ask that YMCA to provide written proof.

### **PRIVATE SWIM LESSONS**

Individual swim lessons provide extra personal instruction and attention in order to improve stroke technique and develop more proficient swimmers. Lessons are geared toward basic, correct body position and introduction to various swimming strokes.

Private swim lessons are available for youth and adults ages 3 and older. Lessons are conducted 1-on-1 with a trained YMCA swim instructor. Due to popularity of private lessons and limited instructor availability, advanced planning and reservations are required. Please contact the East Valley Family YMCA's aquatics department for more information.

### **SEMI-PRIVATE LESSONS**

Do you have family or friends that are interested in learning to swim in a class together? Private group lessons are geared for small groups of similar swim levels to learn in a group environment. Lessons focus on improving stroke technique and proficiency in various strokes. Please see our Member Service Center for more information.

## **AQUATICS CANCELLATION POLICY**

Cancellations and session transfer requests are subject to a \$15 processing fee.

### **REFUNDS & CREDITS**

All cancellations must be submitted in writing prior to the start of the session. Cancellations filed before the start of the session are eligible for a refund, based upon director's approval; however, cancellations are subject to a \$15 processing fee. All cancellation requests filed after the start of session will be charged for the classes that have been missed, regardless of attendance. Fees for missed classes, as well as a \$15 processing fee, will be deducted from the amount paid, the remaining balance will be credited back to your YMCA account for your enrollment in future programs. Refund requests due to medical reasons must be accompanied by a doctor's note for the processing fee to be waived.

### **PRIVATE AND SEMI-PRIVATE SWIM LESSONS**

Private and or semi-private lesson cancellations must be made at least 24 hours in advance for a lesson to be rescheduled. ONLY one make-up class per session.

### **SWIM LEVEL CHANGES & TRANSFERS**

Transfers of levels, or sessions are only possible if classes are available and are all subject to a \$15 processing fee.

### **MISSED CLASSES**

We cannot provide prorated registration fees, credits or refunds for missed classes. Missed classes cannot be rescheduled, except in the event of an illness, which requires a doctor's note. However, make-up classes can only be scheduled according to class availability. Missed classes due to acts of nature or other unforeseen circumstances cannot be rescheduled.
