Youth Sports Leagues (Ages 5-12)

Y-Sports is for boys and girls who want an opportunity to play in an organized sports program. Skill development, participation, and teamwork are stressed in this noncompetitive program. Teams will be organized to ensure that everyone plays and that all teams have equal ability.

Itty Bitty and Little Sportsters Leagues (Ages 2-4)

Little Sportsters is a weekly (Saturday only) parent/child program that emphasizes skill development, improving self-esteem, fair play, and fun while teaching the fundamentals of sports. The whole family is involved in this program! Little Sportsters is for those who have little or no experience and want to learn and improve their skills in sports. Don't miss this excellent opportunity to introduce your child to sports with the introduction of league play. Due to the young age of the participants, we ask that at least one parent plan on participating with your child each week in drills and games.

Volunteer Coaches

All YMCA youth sports teams are coached by volunteer coaches. Many volunteers are parents who have children on the team. All coaches attend a mandatory Coaches Training. Coaches Clinics, YMCA staff assistance, and drill packets are available. All coaches are fingerprinted, and background checks are run to ensure they are suitable to work with children.
