Have the group circle up (sitting or standing). Toss the ball around or across the circle. When players catch the ball, they should answer the following questions:

- What is your name?
- Are you named for a particular person or reason?
 If so, who or for what reason?
- Do you like or dislike your name? Explain why or tell what you'd like to be called?
- > Where were you born?
- What is important to you about your heritage?
- What one thing would people be surprised to know about you?
- ➤ What are you proud of?
